

## **LEVEL 2 Course Descriptions**

### **EAFI 210: Expressive Arts: Foundations**

**(25 hours)**

A presentation of the work of a variety of Expressive Arts practitioners who have influenced and shaped this field. The focus will be on pioneers whose work is intermodal. While some of those studied will be grounded in the field of Expressive Arts Therapy, this course will focus on adapting the work to Expressive Arts Consulting and Education. Creation of a personal philosophy of practice will be encouraged.

### **EAFI 220: Expressive Arts in the World**

**(25 hours)**

This course is an overview and sampling of some of the many ways that Expressive Arts is being practiced. Multi-media presentations will expose students to the richness of experience and diversity of setting and purpose of the Expressive Arts worldwide. Student exploration of their own vision and area of focus will be an integral part of this experience.

### **EAFI 230: Expressive Arts: The Profession and Business.**

**(25 hours)**

This course teaches the basics of creating an Expressive Arts business or integrating Expressive Arts into an existing career. Content will touch on types of business models, promotion strategies, budgets, proposal writing, goal setting, creating a vision and mission statement, finding your target client, setting up a studio, and more. Special emphasis will be placed on the profession and ethics of this field. A variety of left and right brain learning modalities will be used, including role-play and collage.

### **EAFI 240: Expressive Arts Internship**

**(25 hours: combination of fieldwork and online mentoring)**

This is an opportunity for Level 2 students, who have completed all other coursework, to practice their Expressive Arts facilitation skills in a setting appropriate to their training, profession, and field of interest. Students will set up their Internship placement with the approval and mentoring of their EAFI advisor. This placement may occur in the student's home community. Students will have online mentoring with their EAFI advisor during their Internship.

**Elective credits:** 20 hours (10 hours to be completed through EAFI)
